LODGING

WORKSHOPS



Our committee has organised four workshops:

NOTE: The number of vacancies for each workshop is 20; except for the preparation workshop at the lab of Museum of Lourinhã, for which only 10 places will be available. Vacancies will be filled by order of registry.

<u>Prof. Luca Pandolfi</u>: 2D Geometric Morphometric vs 3D GM: basic elements and applications

Victor Beccari, MSc: Blender for Palaeontologists

Carla Alexandra Tomás, MSc: Fossil preparation and conservation

<u>Dr. Soledad de Esteban</u>: Statistics in paleontology.



Two fieldtrips will be offered on the last day of the congress.

<u>Lourinhã</u>: this field trip will focus on the Upper Jurassic continental deposits around the Lourinhã municipality, where rich vertebrate assemblages, including dinosaurs, have been found.

<u>Peniche</u>: this fieldtrip will focus on the Toarcian GSSP, and subsequently will include Pleistocene Furninha cave. We will have the opportunity to explore a rich invertebrate assemblage and one of the most striking quaternary fauna of Portugal.

Participants of both fieldtrips will lunch at the Dinopark Lourinhã and visit it. The fieldtrips will finish around 17:00-18:00 at Lourinhã. The price for the field trips will be 10 euros.



PALEOART CONTEST



During the congress the V paleoart contest of EJIP will be taking place at the municipal gallery of Lourinhã. The original works can be sent to A4 or A3 format to the mail editorial.ejipimerp23@qmail.com, until the 14 of March.

They will be printed in k-line to be exhibited at the municipal gallery for a period to be determined, as well as potentially at Museum of Lourinhã and/or Dinopark of Lourinhã. The prizes will be 150 euros and the book "Mesozoic art" offered by paleoartist Simão Mateus.

The jury will be composed by one member of the committee, one paleoartist and one scientist. There will also be a popular vote for another prize to be determined.

ABSTRACTS, TALKS AND POSTERS ()

The abstracts will be <u>300 words</u> long and <u>in English</u>, in arial, justified, with no extra spaces between paragraphs, and they must be conforming to the template. The abstract book will be published in collaboration with Sociedad Española de Paleontologia. <u>The submission will be open until the 17th of February</u>. There is a limit of two abstracts per main author for the registration. The template for abstracts can be found at the webpage of the congress:

The talks can be in English, Spanish, or Portuguese, but slides must be written in English. However, we encourage the use of English also for the talks. These will be 10 minutes long, with another 5 minutes for questions.

The slides should be sent to the organisation before the meeting. The use of videos or other audiovisual media should be communicated to the organisation beforehand. Authors with oral communication can attend via Zoom. Poster session must be presencial.

The posters will be vertical in <u>A1 size</u> (594 x 841 mm) and in English. The organisation will be available to print them before the meeting (deadline for sending these will be 24 of March) by paying an extra fee of 10 euros.



Two prizes will be offered, one by Society of Spanish Paleontology and other by the enterprise Transmitting Science, for the best poster and talk.

Two roundtables will be organised during the congress.

The first one will be about "Inclusivity in paleontology", will address the impediments women, LGBTQIA+ community, persons of color, and neurodivergent people can encounter in their early career (and even later) in paleontology and academic research; and which solutions can be implemented to solve them and create safe, inclusive, and adapted working environments.

The second one, and the other about "Portuguese paleontological heritage", will explore what is done in Portugal to protect geological and paleontological heritage, with entities such as the Aspiring Geoparque Oeste, which issues researchers may encounter, with notably the challenge of fossil hunters, and what could it be improve compare to other countries legislation, such as Spain.
